## Message from Show Chair, Roger Laylin:

We need to make decisions soon about this year's Show advertising and several other matters.

- Billboard results last year were not good; the entry survey indicated that more people attended as a result of information from friends and from show flyers rather than information from other sources.
- This year we could purchase: a) yard signs [fifty 8" x 24" signs, printed both sides with wire for about \$500]; and b) ads in the place mats that many of the restaurants use [price is yet to be determined, but should be reasonable]. Three different companies print the place mats, so we can shop around.
- At our Show-Wrap Up meeting last December, we discussed offering each student class some financial assistance (\$100) to help cover transportation costs. The past two years have shown a marked decrease in children's attendance on Friday morning (< 500 each year). Two factors appear to have affected attendance: 1) declining school budgets and 2) the shift of Earth Science to the Spring semester for Lansing schools. At present, we can't predict October conditions (but school budgets aren't increasing). The bus-subsidy proposal should be examined and a decision made.
- The use of Gum Ball Machines to sell tumbled stones was discussed several years ago, but no action taken.
- The Mineral I. D. (WHAT'S MY ROCK'S NAME) table was proposed last fall, but no action was taken.
- The development of a CD-DVD advertising the Show to Schools was proposed, but no action was taken.
- We also talked about setting up a table (s) at the Show on Saturday and Sunday for kids to create their own Mineral Kit; prepared mineral kits would be available for Friday morning.

We need to take some time at the June meeting to discuss these interesting ideas and any other ideas the membership might wish to bring forth, approve those we like, and get volunteers to work on them!
