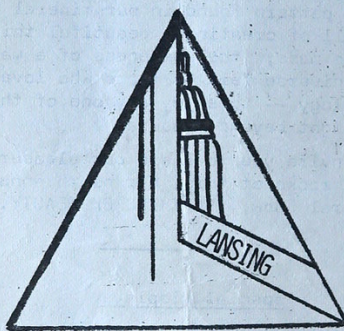


OCTOBER
